Come on **Saturday JUNE 8th** from 9-11 am

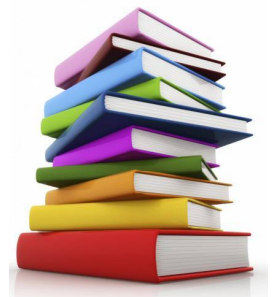
Our Board of Directors and Community Engagement Committee invite you to a neighborhood social event.
